











Growing Amtrak Service Nationwide






Corridor ID Obligation Status



Daily Sunset Limited - Corridor ID Update

Purpose: Restore daily service to the current three times per week *Sunset Limited* service, which last operated daily in 1970, prior to the inception of Amtrak. The *Sunset Limited* is one of two long distance services that operate less than daily.

- The project will identify infrastructure improvements along the corridor and assess restoring passenger service through downtown Phoenix, last served in 1996
- Obligated for Step 1 (scoping) in August 2024
- Received FRA final approval on all Step 1 deliverables in February 2025
- Anticipate Step 2 (Service Development Plan) obligation in late spring/summer 2025


